# JANUARY 2020

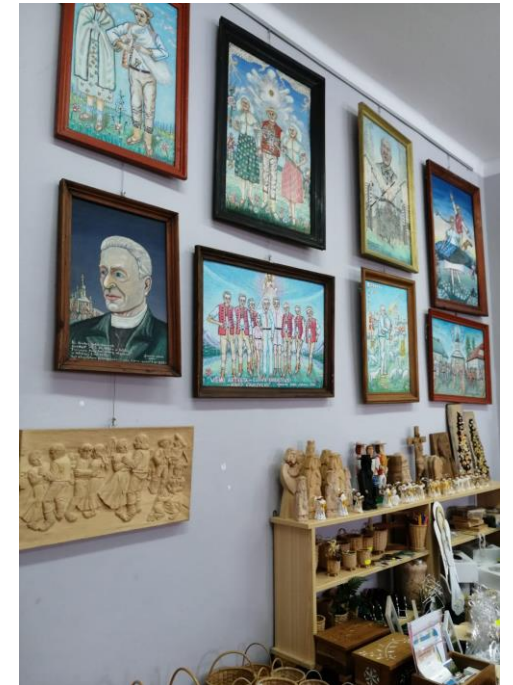
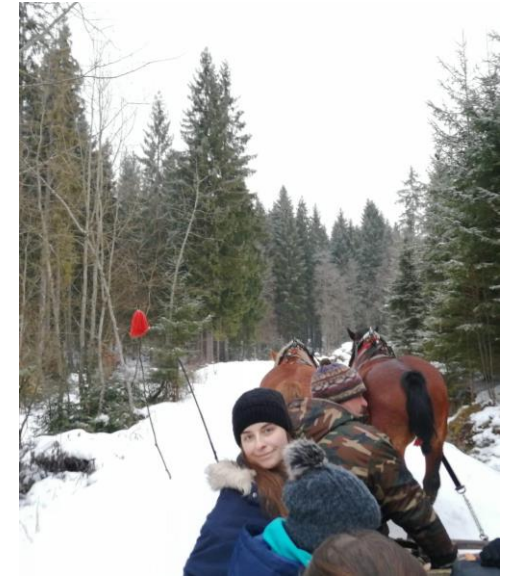

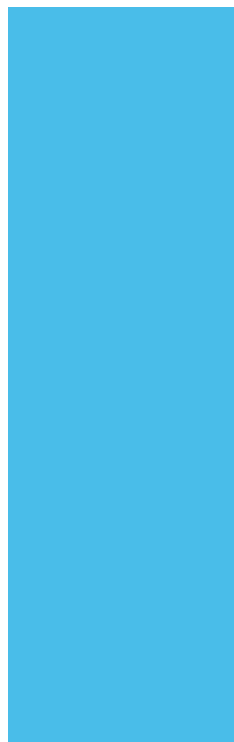
The students are also good Polish teachers to us. We enjoyed working with them a lot. They are spontaneous, motivated to learn. They make us feel useful.

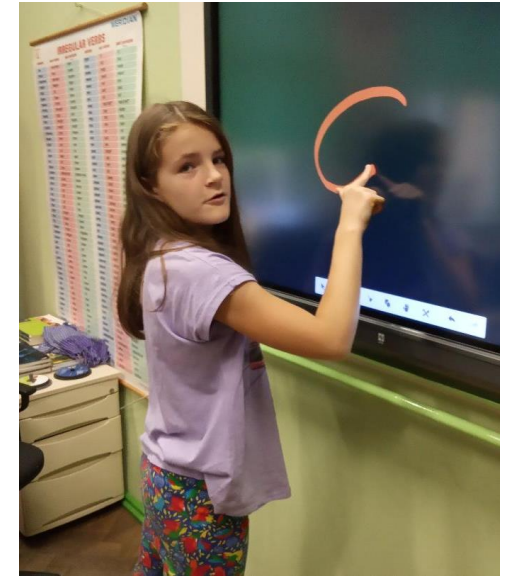
# FEBRUARY 2020

# FEBRUARY 2020

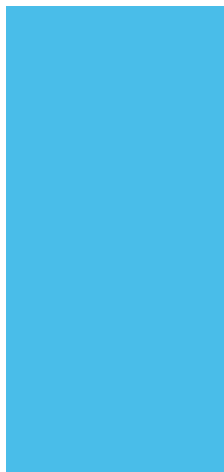
After the winter break we had Open Doors at the ECDiE Foundation. We organized games for the children in English and Polish. I participated in these games with my teammate, Reni.
