

Report school trips – May 2021

On **Tuesday 25th** we went to the Zoo, it was my first time in the Zoo in Wroclaw, and just like the kids I was really happy to take part in it. We saw a lot of different species of animals. For me the most impressive was the Afrykarium. The word Afrykarium is a mix of the words *Afrika* and *Aquarium* : this part of the Zoo is indeed dedicated to the aquatic environment of Africa. I am fascinated and interested in the aquatic world, I often watch films about the ocean, its inhabitants and its mysteries, so for me being surrounded by sea animals was amazing.

There we could observe sharks, turtles, rays, and other species of fish ; crocodiles, manatees, hippopotamus, African seals, African penguins....

Botanical Garden

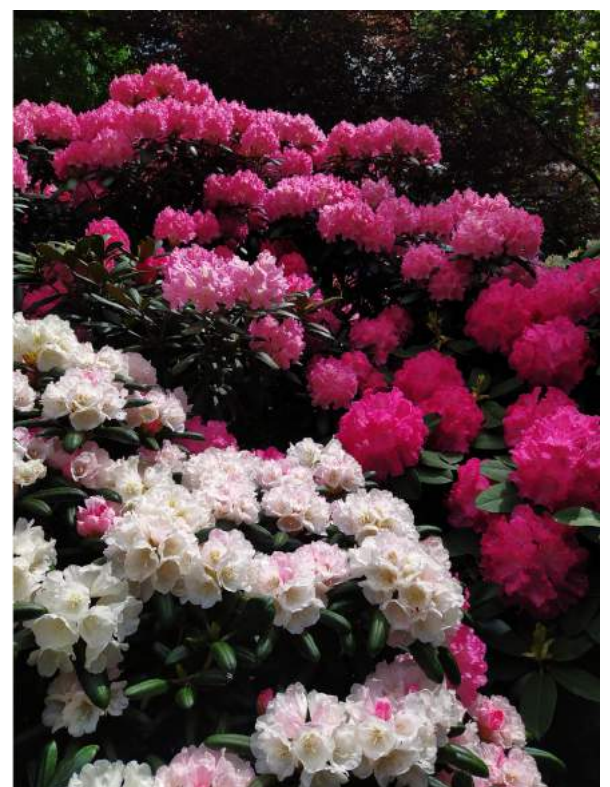

After this break we walked to the Church island, observed the beautiful Katdera. We talked about the history of the city. We ended the day eating pierogi in a nice restaurant.
